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1969 302 Engine

The Ford Boss 302 is a high-performance "small block" 302 cu in (4.9 L) V8 engine manufactured by Ford Motor Company. The original version of this engine was used in the 1969 and 1970 Boss 302 Mustangs and Cougar Eliminators and was constructed by attaching heads designed for the planned 351 Cleveland (which debuted the following year) to a Ford small block. The engine was introduced on April 17, 1969. About 8,600 Boss 302 engines were built. The Boss 302 block was essentially the next generation of 289 High Performance hardware, but features a forged steel crankshaft, 4-bolt main caps, and screw-in freeze plugs. These modifications were developed as

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part of the 302 Tunnel Port design.

After a very disappointing 1968 racing season Ford designed a new engine specifically for F.I.A. Trans Am competition in 1969, the Boss 302. The engine was introduced on April 17, 1969. About 8,600 Boss 302 engines were built. The Chevrolet 302 V8 engine was produced mainly for the Camaro Z28 from 1967 to 1969 to be used in Club of America Trans Am racing. At the time in order to compete in Trans Am racing, a car's engine had to be 305 cubic inches or less.

To complement the other high-performance aspects of the engine, the 302 cubic-inch engine was fitted from the factory with a single 780-cfm Holley four-barrel carburetor and a dual-plane high-rise intake manifold. This was stock equipment for all three years of production, but in 1969, buyers could opt for an aluminum, dual four-barrel cross-ram intake with two 585-cfm Holley carburetors.

The 302 "G" 4V 1969-71# Boss variant was produced between 1969 and 1971 and was the "big dog" of all the 302 engines. The power plant was offered as both a dealer upgrade showroom car and as a "crate" racing engine for direct use in the Trans Am Series.

The Ford 302 has been used in quite a few Ford, Lincoln and Mercury models over the year including vans, pickup trucks and of course the popular Mustang. Most people know the 302 more commonly as the 5.0 liter engine mostly due to the fact that 5.0 emblems were placed on Mustangs starting in the early 80s.

The key to this engine's power was the large-port, large-valve, quench-chambered, free-flowing heads. The Boss 302 Mustang was offered only for the 1969 and 1970 model years. In a January 2010 issue of Hot Rod magazine, a Boss 302 engine built to the exact specifications, settings, and conditions to the original engine was tested. It produced 372 hp at 6,800 rpm and 325 lb-ft of torque at 4,200 rpm.

The 1969 Mustang did continue with many of the same basic V8 engines available on 1968 models, notably a now revised 302 cu in 4.9-liter Windsor

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engine with 220 horsepower, the 390 cu in 6.4-liter FE with 320 horsepower and the 428 cu in 7.0-liter Cobra Jet engine with an advertised 335 horsepower, however a variety of revised options and changes were introduced, such as a V8 available in 250 horsepower or 290 horsepower tune.

ENGINES The Boss 302 engine, a member of the family of Ford small-block V-8s, was unlike any of the versions (both street and race) issued in 1968. Its basic foundation was a short block that was effectively similar in

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design to that used in the prior Tunnel-Port effort, but with thicker webbing around the main bearing locations.

exceptions do exist. One notable exception is early 1969 Z/28 302 engines, which had the VIN derivative stamped on the side of the block, near the oil filter boss. The VIN derivative is usually stamped with 1/8 inch tall characters. The engine suffix code, on the other hand, is usually stamped with 3/16 inch tall characters.
