Adjusting Monitor Resolution Windows Xp

Use the drop-down menu or slider next to Resolution (XP calls it Screen Resolution) to pick a different resolution setting. In most circumstances, the best choice is 800 by 600 pixels or 1024 by 768 pixels, possibly higher if you're using a 19-inch or larger monitor. The "best" setting is highly subjective to your personal preferences and your equipment.

You can reduce the resolution to enlarge the text, but then it just looks choppy and messy. If you modify the DPI scaling instead, you can maintain the crispness of the screen resolution while making things larger or smaller as you see fit. If you're using a flat-panel display for Windows Vista, the screen resolution is pretty much a given.

How to Adjust the DPI Scaling in Windows Vista - dummies

Windows can detect the difference in sizes and adjust itself accordingly: it's set the laptop to 150% visual scale (on-screen items are 50% larger than standard) and 100%, or default, for the monitor. My eyes are pretty bad, though, so I'd prefer the laptop to be set at 175% so I can read text easier.
