Brown band disease – the disease front has a characteristic brown band made up of microscopic ciliates. The intensity of the brown colour varies with ciliate density. These ciliates eat the coral tissue without burrowing in the skeleton and thus do not leave speckles behind. Brown band disease is very common especially on Acropora corals. It has a rapid rate of progression varying between 20 to 100 mm per day.

Pathogens are largely responsible for coral diseases such as Black Aggressive Band, Black Band Disease, Bacterial Infection, Black Overgrowing Cyanophyta, Fungal Infection, and Lethal Orange Disease. Identification of these pathogens is impossible due to the uncertainty of trying to determine the type of pathogen attacking the coral.

Types of Coral Disease - WorldAtlas

Heuchera sp. (Coral bells) get both fungal and bacterial leaf diseases. Pseudomonas causes "reddish" brown spots that may cause the leaf to distort. Xanthomonas causes small brown angular to circular spots with yellow halos. Anthracnose causes small brown spots.

Coral disease is a natural process, caused by both biotic and abiotic stressors, but certain factors, can exacerbate disease and cause outbreaks. Biotic stressors are those caused by a living organism (e.g., pathogen, parasite) and abiotic stressors are environmental stressors (e.g., changes in salinity, temperature, light).

Causes of Coral Disease | Reef Resilience

White band disease is characterized by complete coral tissue degradation of Caribbean acroporid corals. Two species are affected, Acropora palmata and A. cervicornis (Gladfelter, 1982). The disease exhibits a sharp demarcation between apparently healthy coral tissue and exposed coral skeleton.

Common Identified Coral Diseases - artificial reefs

White pox disease (also "acroporid serratiosis" and "patchy necrosis"), first noted in 1996 on coral reefs near the Florida keys, is a coral disease affecting Elkhorn coral (Acropora palmata) throughout the Caribbean.It causes irregular white patches or blotches on the coral that result from the loss of coral tissue.These patches distinguish white pox disease from white band disease which ...
