Multiply this value by 100% to obtain the percent error: $0.0074074 \times 100\% = 0.74\%$ (expressed using 2 significant figures). Significant figures are important in science. If you report an answer using too many or too few, it may be considered incorrect, even if you set up the problem properly.

The computation of percentage error involves the use of the absolute error, which is simply the difference between the observed and the true value. The absolute error is then divided by the true value, resulting in the relative error, which is multiplied by 100 to obtain the percentage error. Refer to the equations below for clarification.

As a fraction, $10 \div 200 = 0.05$. As a percentage it is: $10 \div 200 \times 100 = 5\%$. 5% of those apples are bad. Example: A Skateboard is reduced 25% in price in a sale. The old price was \$120. Find the new price. First, find 25% of \$120: $25\% = 25 \div 100$. And $25 \div 100 \times \$120 = \30 .

Introduction to Percents - MATH

Relative error is the amount of error your measurement contains when compared to the total measurement. To calculate relative error, subtract the measured value by the real value and then divide the absolute of that number by the real value to get the relative error. We can then multiply by 100% to get the percent error.

Formula - How to Calculate Percentage Error Percentage error is found by dividing the error amount by the original estimate, then multiplying that result by 100%. Percent Error = $(\text{Error} \div \text{Estimated Value}) \times 100\%$ Note: the percent error measures FROM the first value.
