Singular and Plural Nouns. The difference between singular and plural nouns is easy to spot. When a noun indicates one only, it is a singular noun. When a noun indicates more than one, it is plural. Singular Noun Examples. The following sentences contain singular nouns examples. The boy had a baseball in his hand. My horse prefers to wear an English saddle.

Singular & Plural Nouns | Definition, Examples & Exercises

Regular nouns. Most singular nouns form the plural by adding -s. A singular noun ending in s, x, z, ch, sh makes the plural by adding -es. A singular noun ending in a consonant and then y makes the plural by dropping the y and adding -ies.

Singular and plural nouns - EF

Singular nouns that end in 's', 'x', 'z', 'ch', 'sh',or 'ss', form the plural by adding -es. For Examples: bus - buses. bench - benches. box - boxes. dish - dishes. truss - trusses. marsh - marshes. lunch - lunches.

Back to the top. Rule-3: Addition of 's' or 'es' to Nouns Ending with 'o' Rule 3 is the special case to rules 1 and 2, which explains how to change some singular nouns ending with 'o' to plural by adding either 's' or 'es'.

1 To make regular nouns plural, add -s to the end. 2 If the singular noun ends in -s, -ss, -sh, -ch, -x, or -z, add -es to the end to make it plural. 3 In some cases, singular nouns ending in -s or -z, require that you double the -s or -z prior to adding the -es for pluralization.
