Recommended Screen Resolution for Web Design

Ideal screen image resolution (detail an image holds) is 72 pixels per inch. If an image is less than 72ppi, it will appear fuzzy (what we call pixelated).

For example, a square image measuring 360×360 pixels has 360 pixels in each row and 360 pixels in each column.
