Pediatric and emergency nurses reported a higher use of cocaine than other specialties. Oncology nurses reported the highest overall drug use - for all substances combined. Binge drinking was highest among oncology, emergency, and critical care nurses. Prescription drug addiction was not as varied across nursing specialties.

About 1 in 5 initiated with nonmedical use of prescription drugs (20.6 percent, including 12.5 percent with pain relievers, 5.2 percent with tranquilizers, 2.7 percent with stimulants, and 0.2 percent with sedatives).

Nurses tend to abuse prescription medications, such as amphetamines, opioids, sedatives, tranquilizers, and inhalants; this coincides with their workplace environment. 4 Behaviors that may suggest diversion include irritability, nervousness, pupil changes, and working excessive amounts of additional shifts. 4
